### Cyclones Come Back to Win

*Cyclones come back from 3-1 to with 5-3*

Oct. 16, 2010 – Ames, IA Ames/ISU Ice Arena – The Iowa State Cyclones took on the Davenport University Panthers at 7:30 p.m. at the Ames/ISU Ice Arena. The Cyclones were looking for a win against the Panthers after last night's 8-2 defeat.

The Cyclones came out hard during the first period. They had several early power play opportunities but were unable to capitalize on any of them. Playing his second game of the season and saving four shots on goal was goalie **Scott Ismond** (Calgary, Alberta, Can. – Squamish Wolfpack / PIJHL). The game remained scoreless going into the second stanza with 10 shots on goal for the Cyclones.

During the sandwich session, the Cyclones continued playing aggressive hockey. Drawing blood first, the Panthers scored at 19:42. The Cyclones' **Marcus Andary** (Sault Ste. Marie, Mich. – Dubuque Thunderbirds / CSHL) tied the game 1-1 with assists from **Beau Jensen** (Minnetonka, Minn. – Pikes Peak Miners / NAPHL) and **Marcus Malmsten** (Torslanda, Sweden – SC TPS / J20 Elit (SWE)). The Panthers immediately pulled ahead again with a quick goal as well as a power play goal making the score 3-1. The Cyclones' **Mike Lebler** (Penticton, British Columbia, Can. – Nelson Leafs / KIJHL) found a loose puck in front of the net from **Chris Cucullu** (Anchorage, Alaska – Nelson Leafs / KIJHL) and buried it pulling the Cyclones back to within one. The score was 2-3 with 7 shots on goal going into the final period.

After killing off multiple penalties early in the third period, the Cyclones struck first when Lebler scored short handed on a breakaway, tying the game 3-3. Scoring again with a two-on-one pass from Andary was Malmsten putting the Cyclones in their first lead of the weekend 4-3. Securing the victory with an empty-net goal was **Matt Rucinski** (Arlington Heights, Ill. – Rochester Ice Hawks / MJHL) with an assist from Cucullu. The final score was 5-3 with a total of nine shots on goal.

With the win against the Panthers, the Cyclones' record is now 4-6-0. The Cyclones will be back in action next weekend, October 22<sup>nd</sup> and 23<sup>rd</sup> at the University of Illinois Ice Arena. Last season, the Cyclones placed fifth in the CSCHL regular season rankings and were runners-up in the ACHA National Championship game.
