Sun Devils Scorch the Cyclones

Cyclones lose series against the Sun Devils

Oct. 9, 2010 – Ames, IA Ames/ISU Ice Arena – The Iowa State Cyclones took on the Arizona State University Sun Devils at 7:30 p.m. at the Ames/ISU Ice Arena. The Cyclones were out for revenge after last night's loss to the Sun Devils.

The Cyclones played hard during the first period. However, the Sun Devils drew first blood at 10:09 with a two-on-one goal. Iowa State saw many scoring opportunities but were unable to convert them to points. The Cyclones played well, out-shooting the Sun Devils 14-8. The score was 0-1 going into the second stanza.

During the second stanza, the Cyclones did not bring their strongest game. The Sun Devils scored three times during the period on mostly odd-man breaks making the score 4-0 Sun Devils. Because the Cyclones are comprised of mostly rookies, they are still transitioning into the fast-paced game that is college hockey. This hurt the Cyclones who were unable to put points on the board making the score 0-3 with nine shots on goal going into the final period.

Arizona State scored once again at 14:50. The Cyclones needed a comeback during the final stanza. Unfortunately, the Cyclones' shots were not well placed, and they gave the Sun Devils a shut-out with a final score of 5-0 and 35 shots on goal.

Last season, the Cyclones placed fifth in the CSCHL regular season rankings and were runners-up in the ACHA National Championship game.
