### **Cyclones Take First Game of Series in Dominating Fashion**

*Iowa State scores a flurry of 3<sup>rd</sup> period goals leading to 10-1 victory*

**Dec. 10, 2010 – Ames, IA Ames/ISU Ice Arena** – The Iowa State Cyclones took on the University of Iowa Hawkeyes at 7:30 p.m. at the Ames/ISU Ice Arena. The Cyclones were supporting the Muscular Dystrophy Association by hosting “MDA night” where there was a silent auction of players’ jerseys and photographs.

The Cyclones came out with energy during the first period. Iowa State was the first to draw blood when **Brian Rooney (Palatine, Ill. – Chicago Force/CSHL)** scored a back-hander in the top right corner of the Hawkeyes’ net. **Marcus Malmsten (Torslanda, Sweden – HC TPS/J20 Elit)** and **Mike Lebler (Penticton, British Columbia – Nelson Leafs/KIJHL)** gained assists on the goal. Another scoring opportunity arose when **Shawn Crawford (Winnipeg, Manitoba – OCN Blizzard/MJHL)** scored his first goal for the Cyclones with a slapshot from the top of the slot. The Hawkeyes came back late in the period with a slapshot from the right side. There were many scoring opportunities for the Cyclones, but the Hawkeye netminder only let in two of 22 Cyclone shots on goal during the first making the score 2-1 with a Cyclone lead going into the second period.

During the second period, the Cyclones kept up the momentum and controlled the period. Iowa State had Iowa on its heels, keeping possession of the puck most of the period. Cyclone netminder, **Erik Hudson (Spokane, Wash. – Burnaby Express/BCHL)**, faced only two Hawkeye shots on goal, while the Cyclones peppered Iowa’s goalie with 18 shots on goal during the second. The score remained 2-1 going into the final period.

The third period was the Cyclones’ time to shine. The Cyclones scored a flurry of eight goals in twelve minutes during the final period, capping off with **Matt Cohn (Hampshire, Ill. – Chicago Force/CSHL)** scoring a hat trick at 14:02. **Brandon Clark (Spokane, Wash. – Trail Smoke Eaters/BCHL)** also contributed to the flurry with two goals of his own. Iowa State concluded the game with a 10-1 score and 62 shots on goal.

With the win against the Hawkeyes, the Cyclones’ record is now 12-14-0. The Cyclones will be back in action tomorrow, December 11th at the Des Moines Buccaneers Ice Arena at 8:00 pm. For more information visit the Cyclone Hockey website, [www.cyclonehockey.com](http://www.cyclonehockey.com).

The Cyclone Hockey team first appeared at Iowa State in 1965. In 1969 the current head coach, Dr. Alan Murdoch, became involved with the program. The Cyclone Hockey team competes in the Central States Collegiate Hockey League. The CSCHL is a league in the American Collegiate Hockey Association. This season Cyclone Hockey is currently ranked No. 2 in the CSCHL rankings and No. 14 in the ACHA rankings. Last season, the Cyclones placed fifth in the CSCHL regular season rankings and were runners-up in the ACHA National Championship game.
