Cyclones Dominate In-State Rival

Iowa State beats UNI 9-0

Feb. 25, 2011 – Ames, IA Ames/ISU Ice Arena – The Iowa State Cyclones took on the University Northern Iowa Panthers at 8:30 p.m. at the Ames/ISU Ice Arena. This is the last series for Cyclones this season, so the Cyclones were looking for a win.

The Cyclones came out ready to win during the first period. Iowa State drew first blood when **Marcus Malmsten (Gothenburg, Sweden – HC TPS/J20 Elit)** scored with an assist from **Mike Lebler (Penticton, British Columbia – Nelson Leafs/KIJHL)**. The Cyclones scored again a minute and a half later when **David Kurbatsky (San Ramon, Cali. – Owatonna Express/NAHL)** tipped in a pass from **Jon Feavel (North Pole, Alaska – Fairbanks Ice Dogs/NAHL)**. **Brian Rooney (Palatine, Ill. – Chicago Force/CSHL)** was also credited with an assist on the goal. **Matt Cohn (Hampshire, Ill. – Chicago Force/CSHL)** also scored on a power play with an assist from **Cort Bulloch (Fort Wayne, Ind. – Notre Dame Hounds/SJHL)** giving the Cyclones a 3-0 lead. Iowa State had 24 shots on goal going into the sandwich session.

The second period came with another Cyclone scoring streak. Scoring during the period was **Shawn Crawford (Winnipeg, Manitoba – OCN Blizzard/MJHL)**, **Jake Flynn (Wenatchee, Wash. – Wenatchee Wild)**, and **Cohn** scored twice. This was **Cohn's** third hat trick of the season. Assisting on these goals were **Justin Wilkinson (Prince Albert, Saskatchewan – Kindersley Kilppers/SJHL)**, **Erik Hudson (Spokane, Wash. – Burnaby Express/BCHL)** and assisting twice was **Jordan Pascale (Aurora, Colo. – Dubuque Thunderbirds)** and **Bulloch**. This gave the Cyclones a 7-0 lead against the panthers and 14 shots on goal during the second.

The Cyclones score two more times during the third period. Scoring was **Bulloch** and **Feavel**. **Joe Wanat (Schaumburg, Ill. – Dubuque Thunderbirds/CSHL)** assisted on the final goal. The final score of the game was 9-0 with 52 Cyclone shots on goal.

With the win against the Panthers, the Cyclones' record is now 24-17-0. The Cyclones will be back in tomorrow, Feb 25th, at the Ames/ISU Ice Arena at 7:30 pm. For more information visit the Cyclone Hockey website, www.cyclonehockey.com.
