### **Cyclones Show Jayhawks They're Not in Kansas Anymore**

*Iowa State receives its 5<sup>th</sup> consecutive shut-out against the University of Kansas*

**Feb. 5, 2011 – Ames, IA Ames/ISU Ice Arena** – The No. 12 Iowa State Cyclones took on the University of Kansas Jayhawks at 8:30 p.m. at the Ames/ISU Ice Arena. The Cyclones' win against the Jayhawks last night gave them 10 consecutive wins. They were looking to make that number 11 in their rematch against Kansas, which was exactly what they did with an 11-0 victory.

Iowa State's **Brandon Clark (Spokane, Wash. – Trail Smoke Eaters/BCHL)** tipped in a pass from **Mike Lebler (Penticton, British Columbia – Nelson Leafs/KIJHL)** and scored the first goal of the game. **Marcus Malmsten (Gothenburg, Sweden – HC TPS/J20 Elit)** was also credited with an assist on the goal. Increasing the Cyclones' lead 2-0 was **Jordan Pascale (Aurora, Colo. – Dubuque Thunderbirds/CSHL)** when he scored a five spot goal with a pass from **Kyle Ralston (Crystal Lake, Ill. – Chicago young Americans/MWEHL)**. Also scoring during the period was Iowa State's **David Kurbatsky (San Ramon, Cali. – Owatonna Express/NAHL)** with assists by **Jake Flynn (Wenatchee, Wash. – Wenatchee Wild/NAHL)** and **Matt Bennett (Anchorage, Alaska – Kenai River Brown Bears/NAHL)**. The Cyclones were up 3-0 with eight shots on goal going into the second period.

The second period came with another Cyclone scoring streak. Scoring for the Cyclones was **Lebler, Jon Feavel (North Pole, Alaska – Fairbanks Ice Dogs/NAHL)**, **Cort Bulloch (Fort Wayne, Ind. – Notre Dame Hounds/SJHL)**, **Kyle Van (Mentor, Ohio – Alexandria Blizzard/NAHL)** and **Matt Cohn (Hampshire, Ill. – Chicago Force/CSHL)**. **Pascale, Ralston, Bennett, Flynn**, and goaltender **Scott Ismond (Calgary, Alberta – Squamish Wolfpack/PIJHL)** had assists during the period. Once again the Cyclones out-shot the Jayhawks with 14 Cyclone shots on goal and five from the Jayhawks. The score was 8-0 going into the final period.

During the third period the Cyclones scored three more goals. Scoring was **Chris Cucullu (Anchorage, Alaska – Nelson Leafs/KIJHL)** and **Flynn** with assists from **Marcus Andary (Sault Ste. Marie, Mich – Dubuque Thunderbirds/CSHL)**, **Justin Wilkinson (Prince Albert, Saskatchewan – Kindersley Klippers)**, **Feavel, Clark** and **Malmsten**. The final score was 11-0, and Cyclone netminder **Ismond** received his first shut-out of the season. This was Iowa State's sixth season shut-out and 5<sup>th</sup> consecutive weekend sweep.

With the sweep against the Jayhawks, the Cyclones' record is now 22-14-0, and Head Coach, Dr. Al Murdoch currently has 999 career wins. The Cyclones will be back in action next weekend, Feb 11<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup>, at Lindenwood University at 7:30 pm Friday, 4:00 pm Saturday. The Cyclone Hockey team first appeared at Iowa State in 1965. In 1969 the current head coach, Dr. Alan Murdoch, became involved with the program. The Cyclone Hockey team competes in the Central States Collegiate Hockey League. The CSCHL is a league in the American Collegiate Hockey Association. Cyclone Hockey is currently ranked No. 2 in the CSCHL rankings and No. 12 in the ACHA rankings. Last season, the Cyclones placed fifth in the CSCHL regular season rankings and were runners-up in the ACHA National Championship game.
