Cyclones Shut Down the Broncos

Iowa State wins both games of the series against the Broncos

Sept. 25, 2010 – Ames, IA Ames/ISU Ice Arena – The Iowa State Cyclones took on the University of Central Oklahoma Broncos at 7:30 p.m. at the Ames/ISU Ice Arena. After a huge win over the Broncos last night, the Cyclones were excited to replicate their success from Friday.

Both teams came out hard during the first period. The Cyclones came close to scoring at the halfway mark of the period, but the goal was ruled inadvertent. Proving to be evenly matched, the Cyclones remained neck and neck with the Broncos throughout the first period. Cyclones' goalie **Erik Hudson** (Spokane, Was. – Burnaby Express/BCHL) was a wall, stopping all seven of the Broncos' shots on goal. The score remained 0-0 going into the second stanza with eight shots on goal from the Cyclones.

The Cyclones played an intense second period but were unable to commit against the Broncos for most of the second period. Finally at 18:42 Cyclones drew first blood during a power play with a slap shot from the right point from **Jake Flynn** (Wenatchee, Was. – Wenatchee Wild/NAHL) assisted by **Mike Lebler** (Penticton, British Columbia, Can. – Nelson Leafs/KIJHL) and **Brandon Clark** (Spokane, Was. – Trail Smoke Eaters/BCHL). Not even a minute later **Brian Rooney** (Palatine, Ill. – Chicago Force/CSHL) tips one in from **Matt Bennett** (Anchorage, AK – Kenai River Brown Bears/NAHL) and **Chris Cucullu** (Anchorage, AK – Nelson Leafs/KIJHL) making the score 2-0 going into the third. The Cyclones had a total of 19 shots on goal during the second period.

Starting the third period off with a goal was Cyclones' **Cort Bulloch** (Fort Wayne, Ind. – Notre Dame Hounds/SJHL) with a rebound from himself at the top of the crease. Scoring a short-handed goal for the Cyclones increasing the lead to 4-0 was Lebler from **Derek Kohles** (Johnston, IA – Dubuque Thunderbirds/CSHL) at 12:43. Playing solid defense throughout the entire game, Iowa State kept their defense going throughout the third period. The Cyclones had a game total of 38 shots on goal. Hudson, Cyclones goalie had a shut-out game. The final score was 4-0 Cyclones.

With the series win over the University of Central Oklahoma Broncos, the Cyclones increased their record 3-1-0. The Cyclones will be back in action for Hall of Fame weekend next weekend, October, 1st and 2nd at the Ames/ISU Ice Arena facing the University of Oklahoma Sooners. This season Cyclone Hockey is currently ranked No. 3 in the CSCHL pre-season rankings and No. 2 in the ACHA pre-season rankings. Last season, the Cyclones placed fifth in the CSCHL regular season rankings and were runners-up in the ACHA National Championship game.
