### **Cyclones Hammer the Hoosiers** *Cyclones beat Indiana University 7-1*

Nov. 12, 2010 – Ames, IA Ames/ISU Ice Arena – The Iowa State Cyclones took on the Indiana University Hoosiers at 7:30 p.m. at the Ames/ISU Ice Arena. After a series sweep on the road against Kent State, the Cyclones were excited skate on their home ice once again.

The Cyclones came out of the gate hard during the first period. Scoring early on a mini-breakaway from **Matt Bennett (Anchorage, Alaska – Kenai River Brown Bears/NAHL)** and **Kyle Van (Mentor, Ohio – Alexandria Blizzard/NAHL)**, was **James Werner (Orillia, Ontario – Fernie Ghostriders/KIJHL)** putting the Cyclones in the lead 1-0. Scoring again with a one-timer from a blind pass from **Cort Bulloch (Fort Wayne, Ind. – Notre Dame Hounds/SJHL)** was Werner. **Matt Rucinski (Arlington Heights, Ill. – Rochester Ice Hawks/ MJHL)** was also credited with an assist. Unfortunately, Cyclone netminder **Erik Hudson (Spokane, Wash. – Burnaby Express/BCHL)** was unable to shut out the period, letting one by at 11:26. The Cyclones held their lead 2-1 with 12 shots on goal going into the sandwich session.

The Cyclones wished to increase their lead against the Hoosiers during the second period, and did just that. With a pass from **Chris Cucullu (Anchorage, Alaska – Nelson Leafs/KIJHL)** and a mini breakaway, Cyclones' **Mike Lebler (Penticton, British Columbia – Nelson Leafs/KIJHL)** scores on a power play extending the Cyclones' lead 3-1. Not even two minutes later, **Jordan Pascale (Aurora, Colo. – Dubuque Thunderbirds/CSHL)** scores with a wrist shot from the left circle. Bulloch and Werner were credited with assists on the goal. Streaking down the right side, **Jake Flynn (Wenatchee, Wash. – Wenatchee Wild/NAHL)**, fed the puck to a wide open Bulloch in front of the net, increasing the Cyclone lead to 5-3. The Cyclones held onto this lead going into the final period, and had 14 shots on goal.

A minute after skates hit the ice in the final stanza, Lebler found a wide open Flynn from behind the net, and Flynn one-timed it in, increasing the Cyclone lead 6-1. Not waiting too long to score again, was Flynn who slid one passed the Hoosiers' goalie. **Derek Kohles (Johnston, Iowa – Dubuque Thunderbirds/CSHL)** was credited with an assist on Flynn's goal. The Cyclones were able to hold their lead against the Hoosiers and concluded the game with a 7-1 victory. ISU's Erik Hudson saved 27 of 28 shots on goal, and the Cyclones peppered the Hoosiers' netminder with 40 shots.

With the win against the Hoosiers, the Cyclones' record is now 8-9-0. The Cyclones will be back in action tomorrow, November 13th at the Ames/ISU Ice Arena. For more information visit the Cyclone Hockey website, [www.cyclonehockey.com](http://www.cyclonehockey.com).

This season Cyclone Hockey is currently ranked No. 4 in the CSCHL rankings and No. 13 in the ACHA rankings. Last season, the Cyclones placed fifth in the CSCHL regular season rankings and were runners-up in the ACHA National Championship game.
